Site design review approvals shall be effective for a period of one year from the date of approval, unless otherwise specified in the City's site plan approval decision. The Community Development Director shall, upon written request by the applicant, grant an extension of the approval period provided that the application continues to meet the criteria. A property owner or designated representative may initiate a request for a permit extension by filing an application with the Planning Department. In addition, the applicant shall provide any related plans, drawings, and/or information needed to provide background for the request.

B. Approval Period. Site design review approvals shall be effective for a period of one year from the date of approval unless otherwise specified in the City's site plan approval decision. The approval shall lapse if:

1. A grading permit or building permit has not been issued within the applicable approval period, as defined above.

2. Construction on the site is in violation of the approved plan.

B. Extension. The Community Development Director shall, upon written request by the applicant, grant an extension of the approval period, provided that:

1. No changes are made on the original approved site design review plan.

2. The applicant can show intent of initiating construction on the site within the extension period.

3. There have been no material changes to the applicable Code provisions on which the approval was based. If there have been material changes to the applicable Code provisions and the expired plan does not comply with those changes, then the extension shall not be granted; in this case, a new site design review shall be required.

4. The applicant demonstrates that failure to obtain grading permits and/or building permits and substantially begin construction within the applicable approval period was beyond the applicant's control.

This application will not be officially accepted until department staff have determined that the application is completely filled out, signed, the application fee has been paid, and the submittal requirements have been met.
